

### About NRI/PIO/CIWGC/FN Admissions Definition:

### Definition of PIO (Persons of Indian Origin) :

""Person of Indian Origin (PIO)" means a Foreign Citizen (except a national of Pakistan, Afghanistan, Bangladesh, China, Iran, Bhutan, Sri Lanka and Nepal) who at any time held an Indian passport Or who or either of their parents/ grandparents/ great grandparents were born and permanent resident in India as defined in Government of India Act, 1935 and other territories that became part of India thereafter provided neither was at any time a Citizen of any of the aforesaid Countries; or who is a spouse of a Citizen of India or a PIO.

### Definition of FN (Foreign Nationals):

"Foreign National" means the Citizen of Countries other than India who are not of Indian origin as defined under OCI/ PIO.

### **Definition of NRI** (Non-Resident Indian):

"NRI" in this context means Non-Resident Indian as defined in IncomeTaxAct,1961with the following clarifications:

An individual is Non-Resident when he is "not a resident" or who is

An individual is Non-Resident when he is "not a resident" or who is "not ordinarily resident". A person is treated as "not ordinarily resident" when any of the following conditions is satisfied:

- (1) If he/she has not been resident in India in nine out of ten preceding years; or
- (2) If he/she has not been in India for a period of 730 days or more during the preceding seven years.

### Definition of CIWGC (Children of Indian Workers in Gulf Countries):

CIWGC stands for Children of Indian Workers in Gulf Countries. CIWGC is a scheme generated by the Ministry of India for the children of Indian expatriates in Gulf countries looking for admissions at the premier Indian Institutes

#### **Definition of OCI**

#### \* "Overseas Citizen of India (OCI)":

OCI means a Foreign national, who was eligible to become Citizen of India on 26.01.1950 or was a Citizen of India on or at any time after 26.01.1950 or belonged to a territory that became part of India after 15.08.1947. Minor children of such person are also eligible for OCI. However, if the Applicant had ever been a Citizen of Pakistan or Bangladesh, he/ she will not be eligible for OCI.
