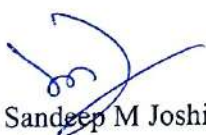

Planning the revision of the B.Tech Curriculum for the Final Year batch of 2023-24.

Discussion

Dr. Sharvari Govilkar briefed all members about the decision to introduce a semester-long internship within the B.Tech curriculum. This initiative aims to meet industry requirements and enhance students' understanding of the corporate environment. She urged all Heads of Departments (HODs) to accommodate the internship within the Semester VIII curriculum.

Continuing the discussion, Dr. Monika Bhagwat proposed that this provision could be facilitated by delivering certain Semester VIII courses through a blended learning approach.

Dr. Arun Pillai suggested that NPTEL-Swayam courses could be offered to students to adopt a hybrid learning model. Additionally, each department could assign a faculty mentor to address any issues related to course completion effectively.

Principal sir requested all the Heads to present the revised curriculum in the next meeting .
